### CALL FOR POSTERS

You are cordially invited to submit a proposal for a poster presentation.

Proposals for posters on specific themes are encouraged.

ACIS encourages proposals from postgraduate students and a small number of partial conference fee bursaries are available – please see application process details on the ACIS and conference websites and encourage your students to consider this.

Below are the suggested thematic areas for posters, which must advance understanding of nineteenth, twentieth and twenty-first century socio-cultural, economic and political issues and realities and relate primarily to Spain and/or Portugal and transnational issues and processes relating to the Iberian Peninsula within the wider Lusophone and Hispanic worlds. Both single-disciplinary and interdisciplinary perspectives are encouraged and the themes listed below are not exclusive.

- Politics, Government, International Relations, the EU, Nationalism, Regionalisms, Transnational issues and processes
- Economics, Business, Labour, Social and Welfare issues
- Cultural Production in all its forms (e.g. film, television, journalism, literature, media, advertising, digital communication & social networking)
- Social and Cultural Studies (e.g. identity, gender, ethnicity, popular culture)

- Leisure, Tourism, Sport
- Contemporary History
- Language, Linguistics, Language Policy
- Education and Pedagogy

The selection of posters will be made by the Conference programme convenors in consultation with the Executive Committee and these decisions will be final.
